## THIRTY-SIXTH LEGISLATURE OF THE VIRGIN ISLANDS

An act providing an appropriation for the operating expenses of the Virgin Islands Career and Technical Education Board from the General Fund of the Treasury of the Government of the Virgin Islands during the fiscal year October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:*

**SECTION 1.** The following sum is appropriated from the General Fund of the Treasury of the Government of the Virgin Islands for operating expenses, including maintenance, supplies, machinery and equipment and other purposes of the Virgin Islands Career and Technical Education Board for the fiscal year October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026.
